<p>Hi folks,</p> <p>I'm quite new to XBMC and PVR... however, I already cross posted my idea/vision on http://forum.xbmc.org/showthread.php?tid=145668.</p> <p>I think it would be a fantastic feature if the backend would (optionally?) notify the client (i.e. the XBMC PVR plugin) if channels become temp. inavailable (because of other clients or recordings occupying tuners/muxes).</p> <p>The Client could then take appropriate action... e.g. grey out the channels in the channel list. Or skip these channels during zapping, etc.</p> <p>FernetMenta respondes pointing to the already available blsHidden flag in XBMC's channel list. However, I think we need to prepare the backend 1st, then the client side.</p> <p>The backend would need to calculate channel availability considering the respective priorities of course... but should be possible, shouldn't it?</p> <p>Best regards Dietmar.</p>
