Description

This has been an issue for quite some time now in master, it has originally been one of the main reasons why I've stuck with 3.4.27. Like the topic says, it's not possible to play a recording while it's recording. In XBMC, the stream never starts (which sometimes leads to XBMC locking up completely for a minute or so). Finished recordings work just fine.

Any logs I can provide? I don't have any at hand at the moment but the issue is easily reproducible.

Seems to be related to the cache scheme in the DVR configuration. Changing it from "Do not keep" to "Unknown" seems to have fixed this issue. I've upgraded my installation from 3.4 so I don't know if "Do not keep" is the default or if it's an issue with the migration, but it seems "Unknown" should definitely be the default behavior if it isn't already.
