I have a problem when trying to record a show in recent builds. The recording doesn't begin properly. Instead the status is "Waiting for stream". With older builds I haven't got this problem.			
r4924 works okay. r4966 and newer builds doesn't work.

Yes, it's fixed. Thanks.

But now I've got other problems: This error occurred only on some channels. Now when I switch to such a channel via XBMC, it takes 5 seconds before playing (probably because of the timeout) and I've got some sound channels without sound. Here's an example:
