<b>Description</b>			
<p>I've created different user profiles for home use and "on the road" use. The traveling profile transcodes the stream down to a cap of 2Mbit/s so it works on most hotel connections.</p> <p>Live TV works like a charm, but TVH ignores the user stream profile when DVR recordings are watched - trying to stream HD content with &gt;10MBit/s via WAN and making it unusable.</p>
