Matroska (and other formats) require global headers.	
We should check that an produce such headers to avoid this:	
[matroska 0x8554ea0]Codec for stream 0 does not use global headers but container format requires global headers	
[matroska 0x8554ea0]Codec for stream 1 does not use global headers but container format requires global headers	
[matroska @ 0x8554ea0]Codec for stream 2 does not use global headers but container format requires global headers
